The project-group scored significantly higher on competency than the control-group. Focus groups with students who participated in the project and interviews with representatives of involved faculties and NGO's demonstrated an increase in the level of competencies of student-teachers when they participated in the project. Further research in the feature is needed to verify and generalize the results to the entire population and to explore the effects of the project and the improved competencies of student-teachers on the inter-ethnic relations in the country.
