- 2. Detail the general outline to the level of detail you prefer



- 1. Decide on key message of the blog
- 2. Decide on 3 main points in the blog, supporting the key message
- 3.Create a storyline in around 100-200 words

Craft your story

Use active and direct language - in contrast to scientific writing

Introduction Has to be **appealing** to the reader. Some ideas:

	 Personal story (anecdote): a place, book, movie, conversation etc. reminded you of the topic News item related to the topic of the blog post
Main text	 Every paragraph: Exists of 1 main idea Connects well with the paragraph before and after (e.g. with a connecting sentence) Has a clear beginning and ending
Ending	 Conclusion/summary Leave reader with an idea/room for thought /action Spice up your story
